Dear Professors and Students,

RE: Green Chemistry Summer School, Venice, 4^{th} to 10^{th} of July 2021 – New application deadline is June 15^{th} .

Forgive our insistence, but we have some updates regarding the Postgraduate Green Chemistry Summer School 2021 that could be interesting for students. Therefore, we would kindly ask you again to share this letter with your networks, colleagues and students.

The situation in Venice is rapidly improving and getting better each day, and Italy is no longer highrisk for Covid-19. Therefore, we can lift the reservation and confirm that the Summer School will be carried out also in person. The Sponsors and the Organizing Committee, in order to encourage students' participation in person, have already provided the following initiatives:

- 1. **IUPAC will fund 4 students to attend the Summer School in person.** Please find here the approved project: https://iupac.org/project/2021-014-1-041
- 2. PhosAgro is kindly providing 4 grants of 500 € each for the best 4 posters presented in presence in Venice. This special grant will be awarded to the best posters which will be seinternational Scientific the lected by an Jury during Summer School. The awards will be assigned to 2 women and 2 men, regardless of the country of origin. In-person participants will present their posters on Monday 5th and on Tuesday 6th, and the winners will be announced on Wednesday 7th. The awards will be given to the winners during the Closing Ceremony, on Friday 9th.
- 3. OPCW is expected to provide other grants for students.
- 4. The United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), in collaboration with the Summer School Organizers, will send to all the participants (online and onsite) a Survey on Green and Sustainable Chemistry a few days before the beginning of the Summer School. Participants will be requested to answer the Survey by the first day (Monday July 5th, 2021), so that the data may be collected and analyzed to be discussed with students before the end of the Summer School.

The **Camplus Santa Marta** (https://www.camplusapartments.it/en/residences/venezia/camplussanta-marta) hosts the conference venue and offers rooms of different size for all participants' stay. This new facility includes single and double rooms, a conference room, breakfast and lunch area, internet facilities and a gym. Each room includes private bathroom, a kitchenette, a fridge, and a microwave.
